Trauma causes the brain to pause, increasing the time needed for a grieving person to absorb information, and often requires adjustments to a professional's communication style.



Each widowed person's experience is unique, making ongoing training for multiple experiences valuable.



The ability to confidently and compassionately acknowledge a client's grief is a key factor in a grieving client's satisfaction and loyalty.



Widowed people are often the sole decisionmakers for their households.
